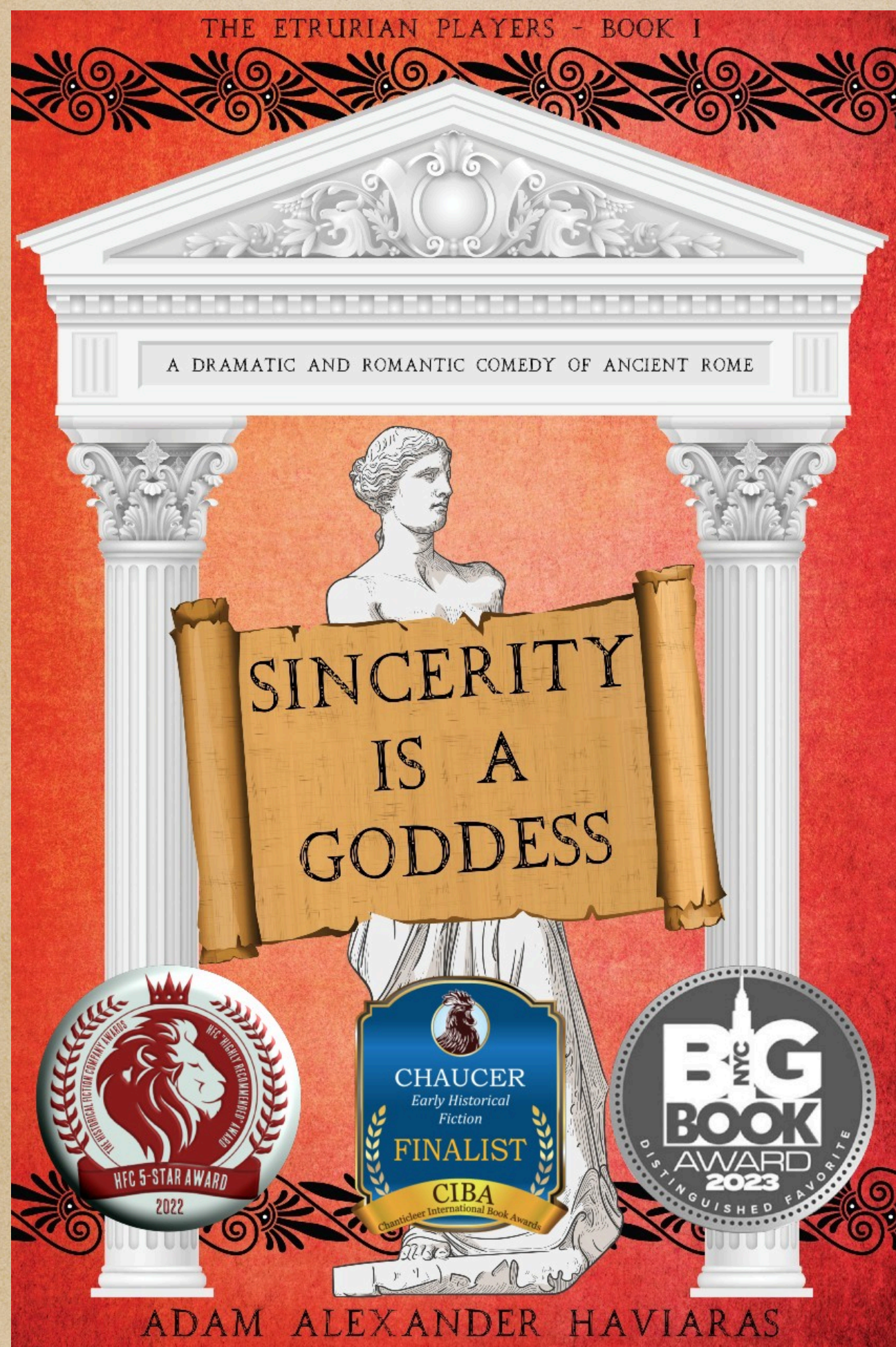

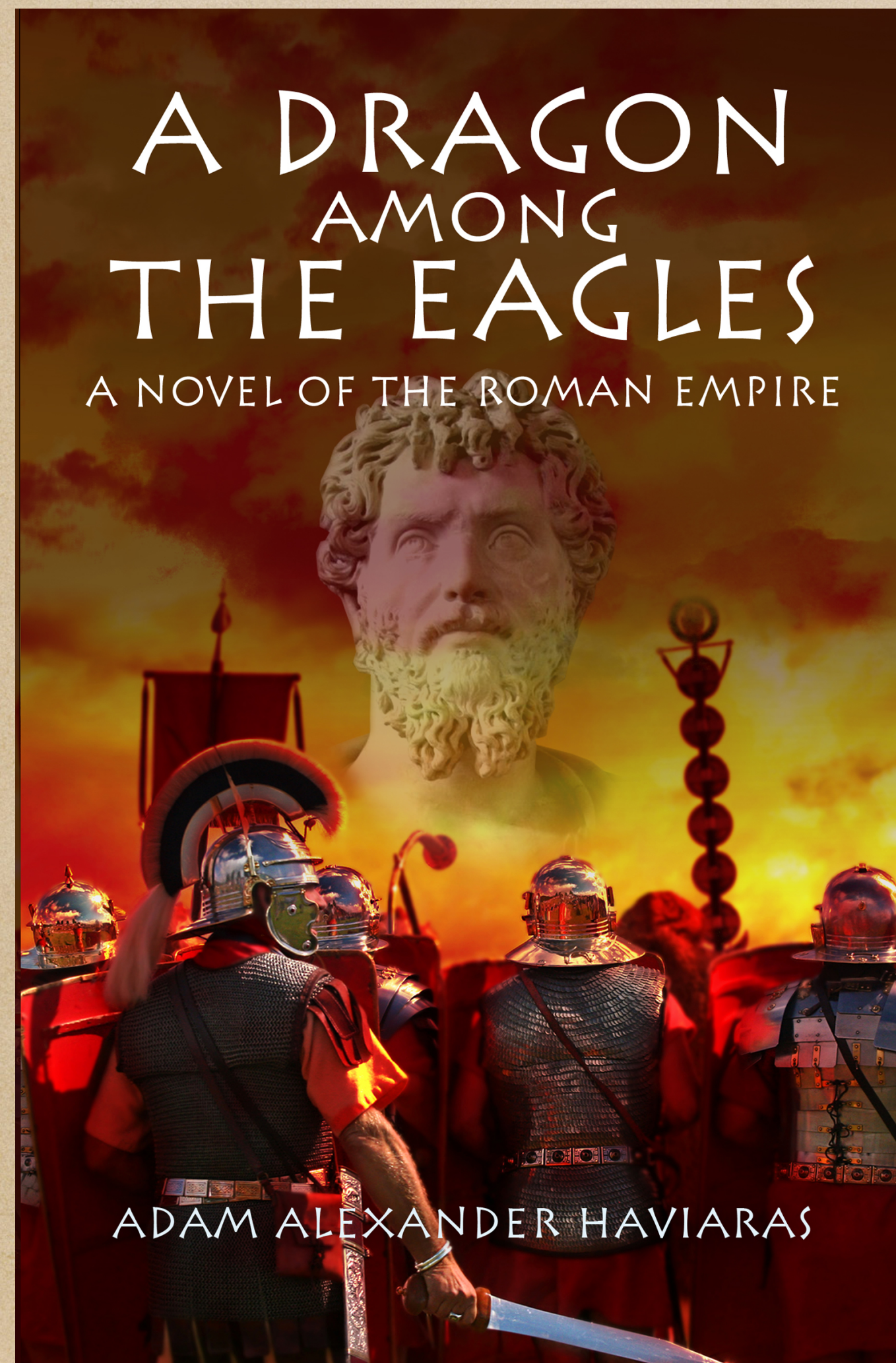

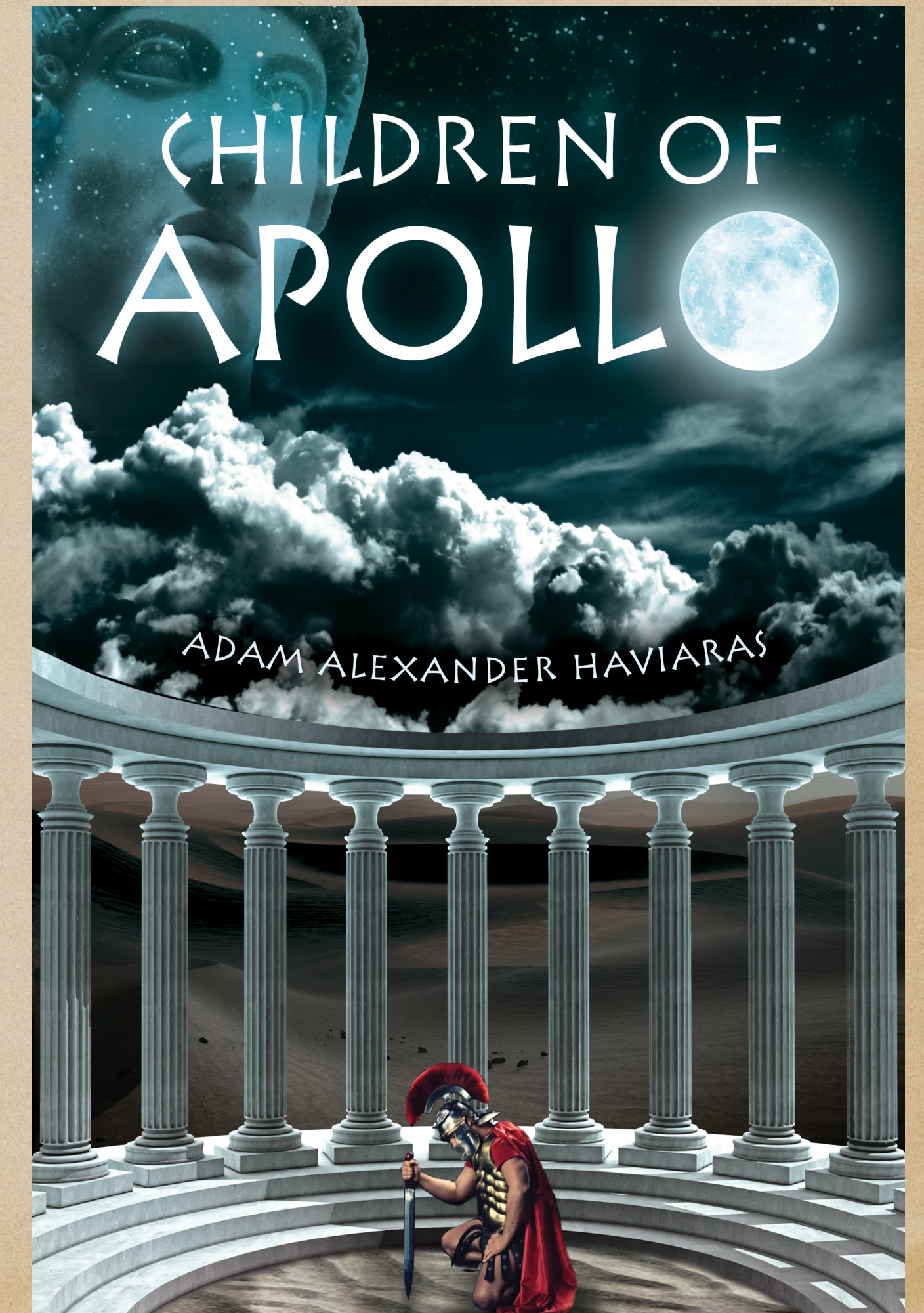

Ultimately, he must choose sides in a war that threatens to destroy his family, his faith and all that he has worked for.

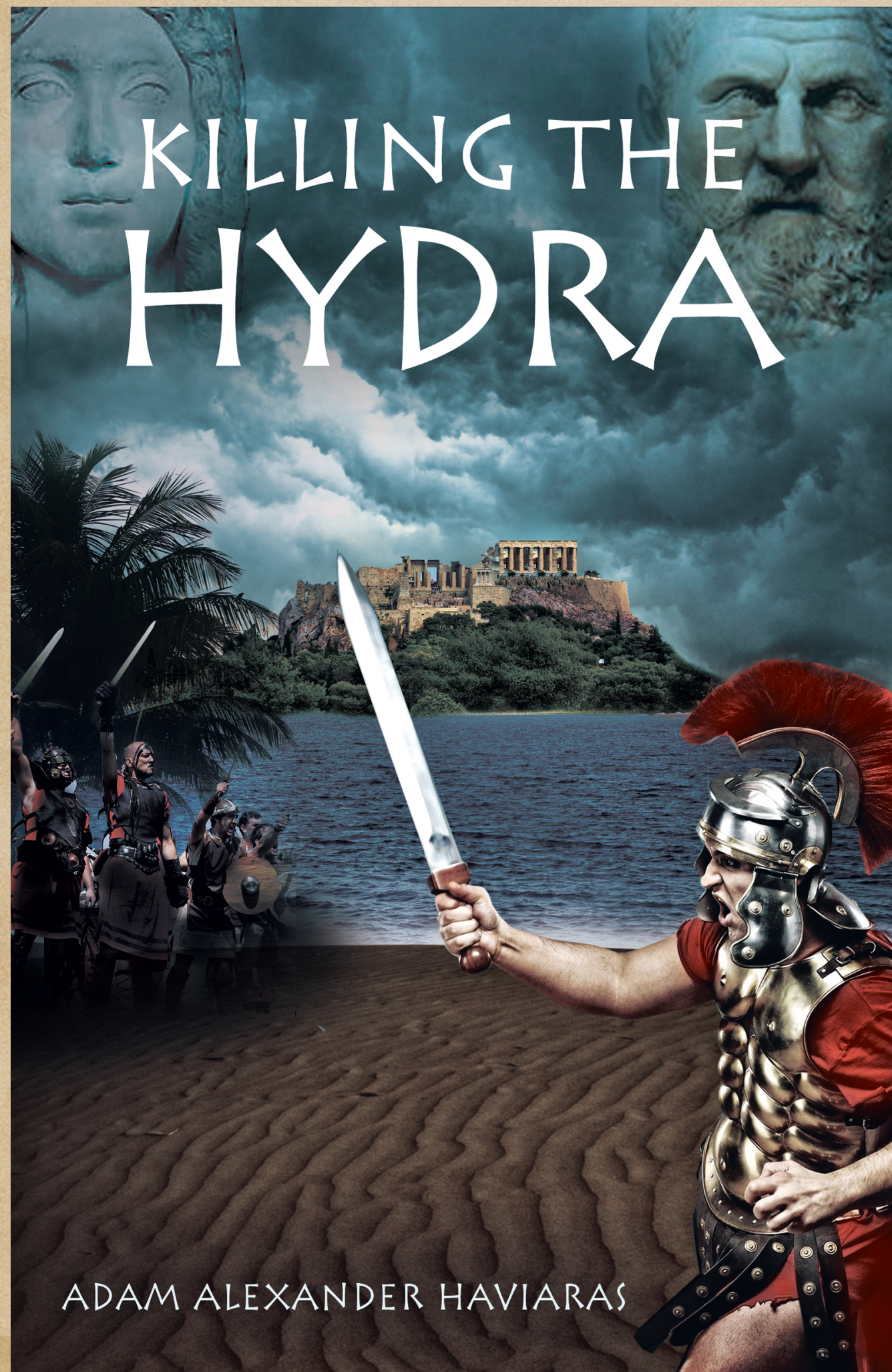
